University College Dublin is one of Europe's leading research-intensive universities. Founded in 1854 by John Henry Newman UCD has grown to become Ireland's largest university with almost 25,000 students.

Accommodation is provided in Merville residence on the main UCD campus close to the Owenstown Park entrance. Each apartment is broken down into three or four single bedrooms, two bathrooms and a kitchen and living space. There is an onsite convenience store in the residence as well.



Between the University sports centre and the adjoining St Killians German School there is a great combination of sports facilities available to students at the MLI summer school including an indoor sports hall, Astroturf pitch, tennis courts, football and rugby pitches as well as a brand new Olympic sized swimming pool.

UCD is situated at Belfield on a 132 hectare site just 4Km south of Dublin city centre. The campus has been attractively land-escaped with all facilities provided on site for students. Access to the city centre is easy with bus routes starting and terminating on campus as well as many other routes serving the university and surrounding area. With the city centre only 15 minutes away by bus it is an ideal location to discover everything that Dublin has to offer.
